WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Board of Commissioners for the Fort Myers Beach Mosquito Control District held a tentative public budget hearing on September 3, 2025, at 5:01 p.m., at 161 Bay Road, Fort Myers Beach, Florida 33931, to adopt a tentative millage rate for the District's fiscal year commencing October 1, 2025, and ending on September 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the Fort Myers Beach Mosquito Control District, that:

SECTION THREE: MILLAGE RATE

The Board of Commissioners does hereby adopt and set its tentative operating millage rate at 0.1123 (\$0.1123 per \$1,000.00 of net taxable assessed value) for the fiscal year 2025/2026, which begins October 1, 2025, and ends September 30, 2026. The above stated tentative millage rate of 0.1123 mills is greater than the rolled-back rate from the DR-420MM-P form for 2025/2026 by 10.3%.
